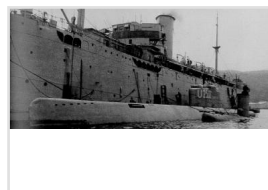
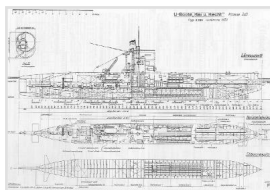

U-2365 ... has been raised in 1956 for FRG U-2359 57:29 N 11:24 E lies in the Kattegat U-2338 ... has been raised in 1952 for DK U-2524 55:55 N

10:45 E lies east of Samsø (RAF lost thereby one beaufighter by flak) U-2367 ... has been raised in 1956 for FRG, BUT at 55:00 N 11:00 E she had a collision with unidentified German U-boat. The distance between german wreck an point of collision is ca. 60 km inside the Store Bælt. Are there any further news about the unknown wreck ("danish U-who") until now? mvh fra Hamburg Ulrich
